Sarah and John are now living in the United States, but they plan to return to Samar one day. They want to raise their children in the Philippines, and they want to share their love of Filipino culture with them.

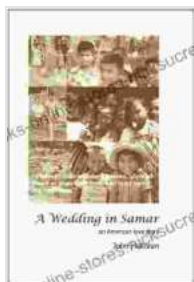
"We can't wait to go back to Samar," Sarah said. "It's our home away from home."

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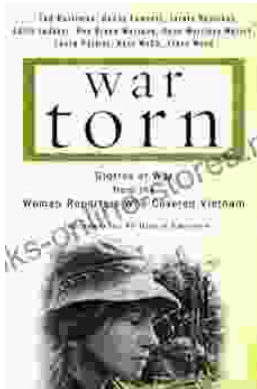
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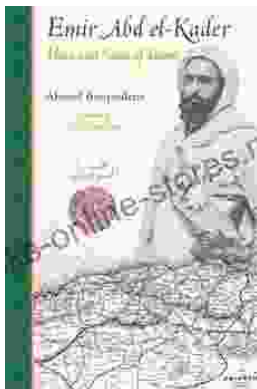
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
