

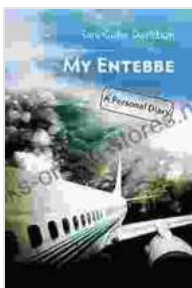
My Entebbe Personal Diary: A Journey to the Heart of Uganda

Day 7: Lakeside Farewell

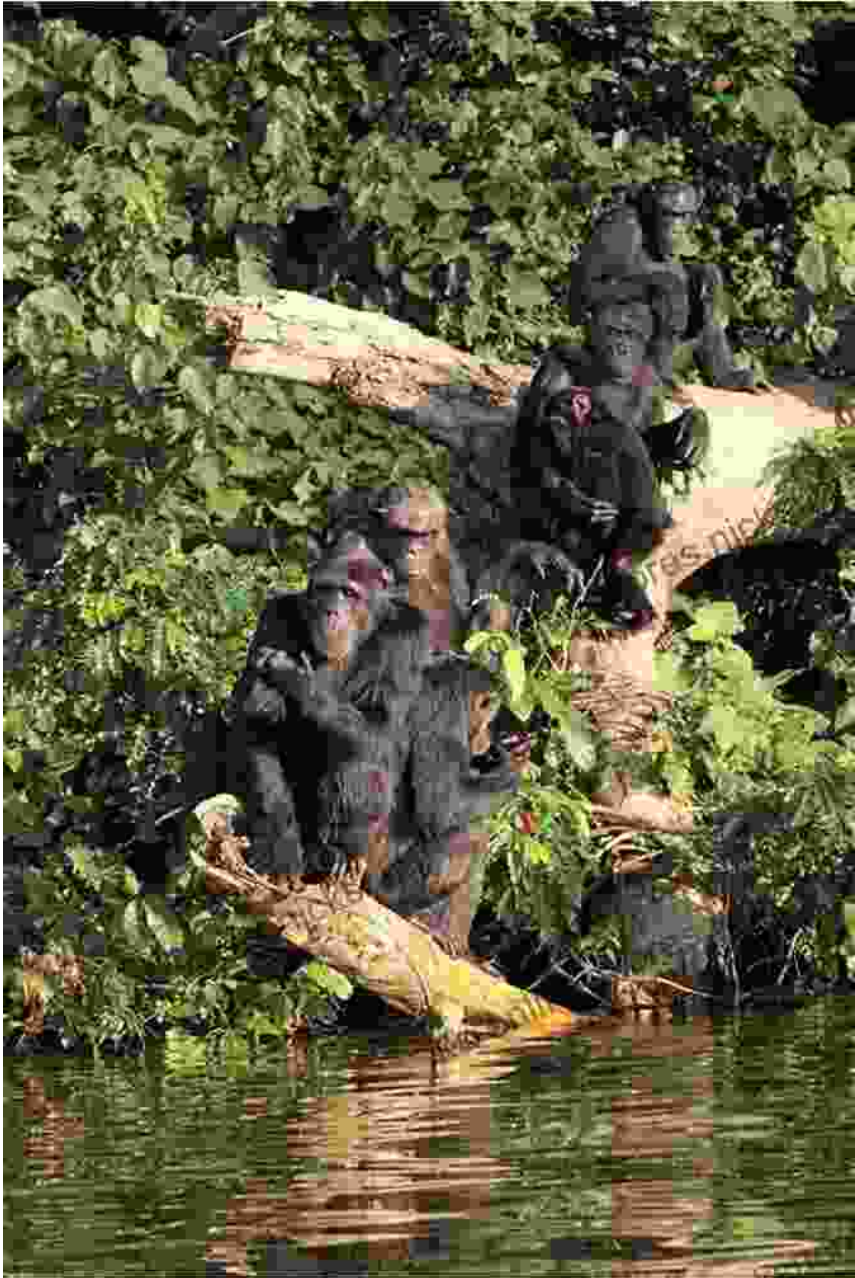

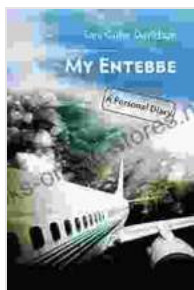
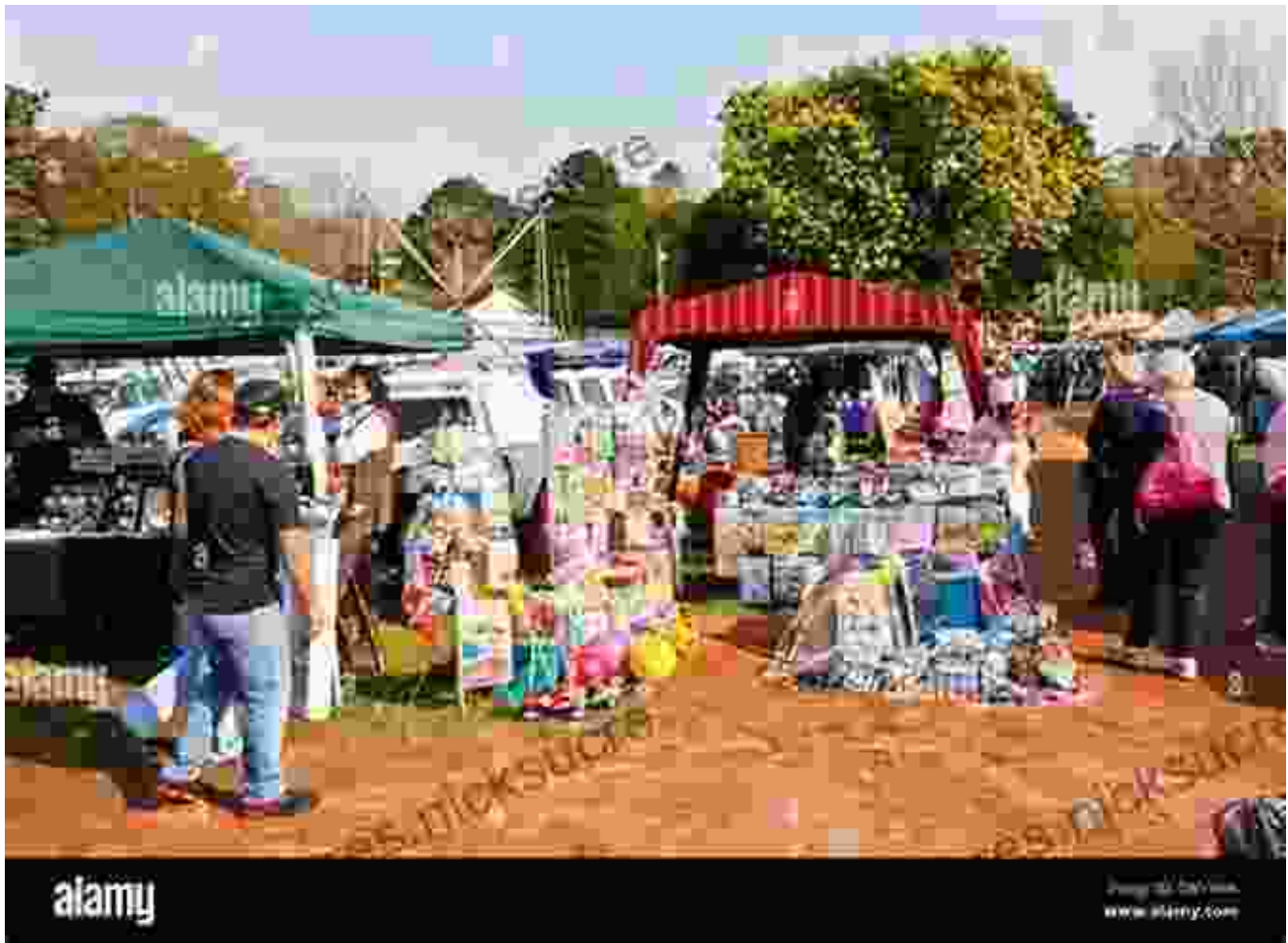
