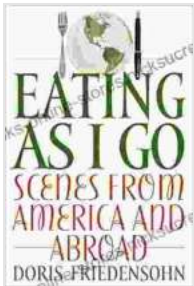

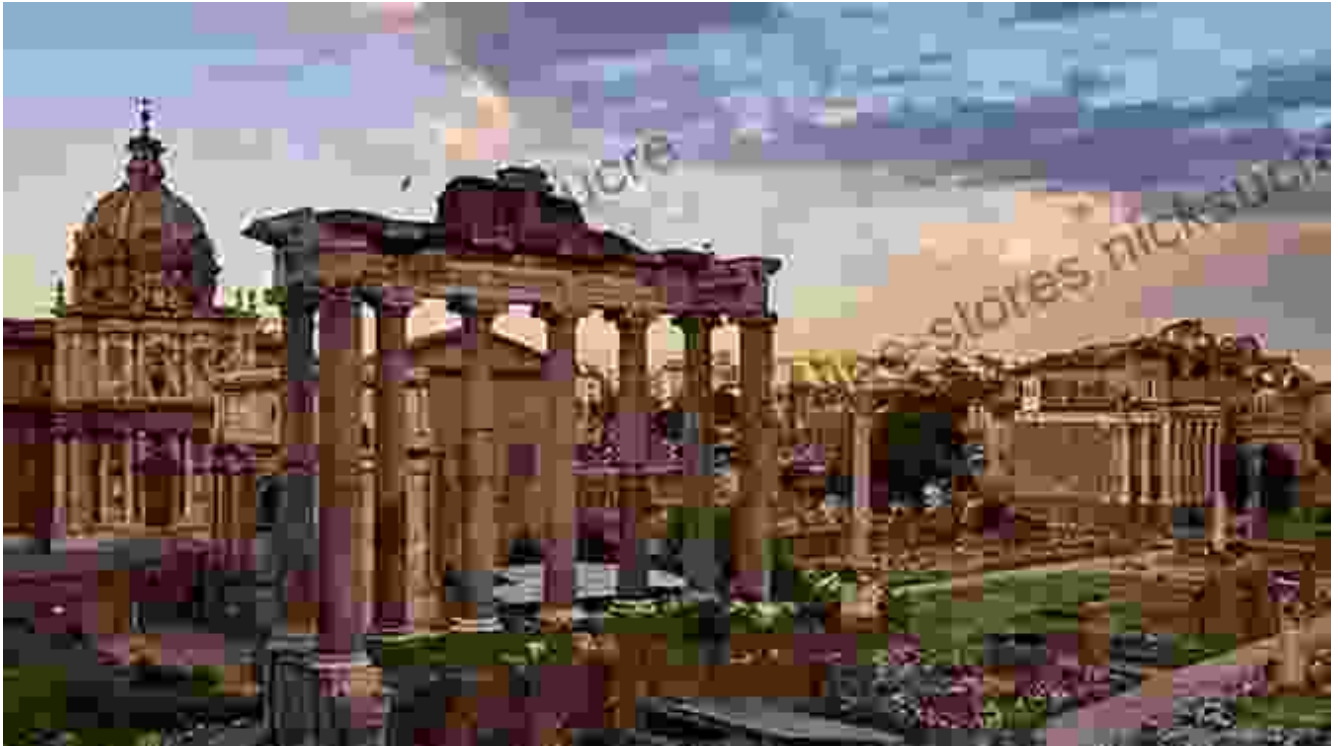

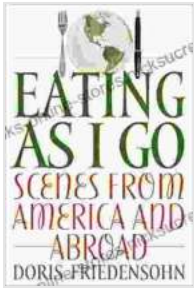
In addition to Europe, I have also photographed in Asia, Africa, and South America. I am always eager to learn about new cultures and to see the world through different eyes.

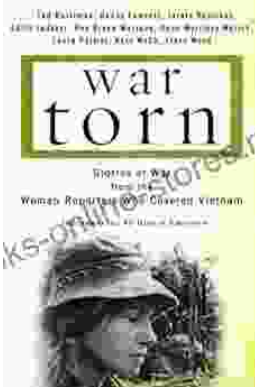

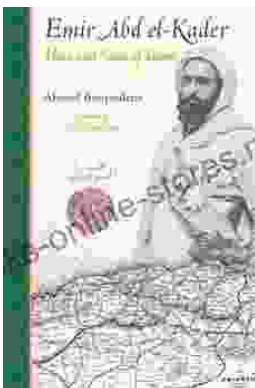
