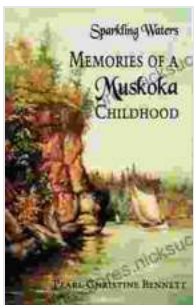


# Sparkling Waters: Memories of a Muskoka Childhood

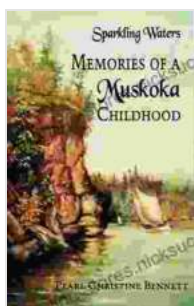

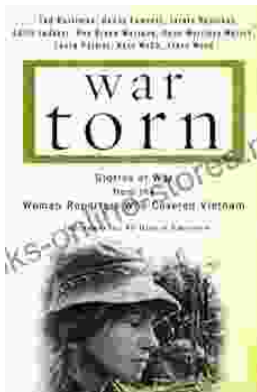

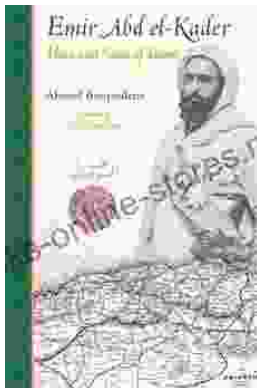
